This is going to be a great surgery. We as residents are going to have a very modern building and something we should be proud of.

I Had a County lines briefing last week which was done by Norfolk Constabulary and outside agencies. This was a very interesting briefing. We all need to be aware of the dangers of the issues surrounding drugs and the involvement that the younger generations are getting enticed into.
