

NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

Referendum on the adoption of the Burnham Market Neighbourhood Plan

1. The referendum will take place on **Thursday 21 September 2023** to decide on the question below:

‘Do you want the Borough Council of King’s Lynn and West Norfolk to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Burnham Market to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?’

2. The last date for registering to vote in respect of the Neighbourhood Planning Referendum is **Tuesday 5 September 2023**.
3. New postal vote (including proxies applying to vote by post) applications, changes or cancellations to existing postal, postal proxy or proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King’s Court, Chapel Street, King’s Lynn PE30 1EX by **5 pm on Wednesday 6 September 2023**.
4. New applications to vote by proxy (not postal proxy) at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King’s Court, Chapel Street, King’s Lynn PE30 1EX by **5 pm on Wednesday 13 September 2023**.
5. New applications for Voter Authority Certificates (VACs) at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King’s Court, Chapel Street, King’s Lynn PE30 1EX by **5 pm on Wednesday 13 September 2023**.
6. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King’s Court, Chapel Street, King’s Lynn PE30 1EX by **5 pm on Thursday 21 September 2023**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after **5 pm on Wednesday 13 September 2023**. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after **5 pm on Wednesday 13 September 2023**.
