

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (WTRO4284) affecting the A149 Wells Road from its junction with U22318 Gong Lane for 140m eastwards in the PARISH OF BURNHAM OVERY to facilitate Openreach blockage clearing works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) between 20:00 on 26th September and 06:00 on 27th September 2023 for the duration of the works expected to be about 10 hours within the period.

Alternative route is via: Wells Road, Tower Road, Burnham Overy Footpath 10, Bellamys Lane, North Street, Overy Road, Mill Road, Burnham Road, Model Farm Road, Main Road (Burnham Norton, Burnham Overy, Holkham, Burnham Thorpe, Burnham Market).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
